There is no information in Historical files, Operations Reports, concerning the death of 2nd Lt. Ira B. Cheaney, Jr., ASN 023965, for the 30 January 1942.

The following summation of the Operations with the enemy for that period is given as follows......

Reorganization of Position on January 30, 1942

On January 30th, the I Corps Sector had been reorganized into: a Right Sub-Sector (Brougher); a left Sub-Sector (General A. M. Jones, who had joined the Corps on January 26th, with a portion of Division Headquarters, 51st Division); a South Sub-Sector (Pierce). Thr troops assigned to the Right Sub-Sector were: 11th Division with 2d Philippine Constabulary (less one battalion) attached, boundaries the same as those assigned to 11th Division in withdrawal order; Troops assigned to Left Sub-Sector were: the 91st Division, 1st Devision and a provisional battalion of stragglers from the 51st Division, who had crossed into the sector of I Corps after the penetration of the 51st Division front in the Mt. Natib area. The boundaries were those assigned originally to the 9Ist Division and 45th Infantry (PS). The South Sub-Sector had been reinforced by the 45th Infantry (less one battalion) and the 57th Infantry (PS). The boundaries of the is Sub-Sector were the Binuangan River and the Panikian River. The 11th FA with Battery F, 24th FA attached, supported the Right Sub-Sector; the 91st FA with detachments of the 71st FA attaches, supported the Left Sub-Sector; the 24th FA (less Battery F) and a group of six 155mm guns were in general support of the Corps. The Command Pest I Corps, was established at KP 210.9 West Road.

The Defense of the Beaches

On January 30th, Colonel Lilly, 57th Infantry wasplaced in command of operations ad the 57th Infantry (less 2d Battalion) reenforced. 1st Battalion, 12th Infantry and 2d Battalion, 45th Infantry attacked in line and reached the beach at Canas Point and Quinauan River encircling the Japanese Force. An attempt by Japanese to reenforce this area on the night of January 30th - 31st was repulsed.

Lt. Cheaney departed from San Francisco, Calif. on 11-1-41 on the transport "Coolidge". Arrived at Manila, Pl. on 11-20-41.

These tactics had resulted in many casualties, and consequent lowering of morale among the personnel of Lieutenant Cheaney's battalion. Understanding the seriousness of the situation, this officer assembled a group of enlisted men and undertook to drive out the hostile snipers. Leading a group personally in repeated charges into the position occupied by the enemy, Lieutenant Cheaney successfully silenced the damaging enemy fire and relieved the severe pressure on his unit. This office promised to inform you upon receipt of information pertaining to the resting place of the remains of your son, the late First Lieutenant Ira B. Cheaney, Jr.

The official report of burial has been received, and I am gratified to inform you that the remains of your son have been recovered and are now resting in Casket 5281, in the American Graves Registration Service Mausoleum, Manila, Philippine Islands.

Our records indicate that the remains of your son were recovered from an isolated grave in the churchyard of the Abucay Parish Church, Abucay, Bataan, Philippine Islands, and were properly identified by the favorable comparison of a tooth chart made for the remains with dental data maintained in your son's Army records and by the fact that the estimated date and place of death for the deceased are in agreement with records of the Adjutant General's Office as to date and place of death of your son. 

"Mr. Cheaney may be assured that every possible clue is exhausted in our endeavors to locate and identify the remains of our World War II dead. Then further information is received concerning Lieutenant Cheaney, both you and Mr. Cheaney will be immediately advised."

"Inasauch as The Adjutant General, this city, is the agency responsible for information concerning circumstances surrounding the death of those who died during World War II, copies of our correspondence have been furnished him for further direct reply to you."

Dear Mr. Nixon:

Tuesday Night, at Toast Master's meeting I asked Ray Scott if he thought you might get some information as to the details of my son's service and death in the Philippines. He said he would mention the matter to you and for me to write to you.

The Background facts are as follows:

My son 2nd Lt. Ira B. Cheaney Jr. (Serial #023965) was sent to the Philippines in Nov. 1941. We received a wireless on his arrival and a letter written a day or so later in which he said that he had been assigned to the Philippine Scouts and that his Colonel's name was Clark.

Then Pearl Harbor stopped all mail, but we received a form cable about the Middle of Dec. saying that he was still O.K. The only other message received was a letter written on Bataan in December and held up for delivery until 1944.

Feb. 125h 1942, we received a telegram from the war department stating that he had been killed in action Jan. 30th.

That telegram is the only message or information of any kind that the government has sent us, except the copy of the citation which was presented with the Distribuished Service Cross, and a printed poster over Roosevelt's signature "in appreciation etc, etc". Only Franklin Roosevelt would have had the unmitigated gall to send that just Before the 1944 elections.

We read in the papers in the spring of 1942 that he was listed as having received the Distinguished Service Cross but the newspapers had no details and of course we could give them none. Then about a year later the O.W.I. or the Army Public relations decided it was time for a little publicity so they presented the Medals to his wife in a ceremony at Ft. McArthur. We were given a copy of the citation then, and later, when his wife remarried she gave us the Medals. The citation was dated Jan. 28, 1942, and was for First Lt. We do not know if this was an error or if he had been promoted in the field.

Then on June 13th 1942 we read in the papers that Col. G. S. Clark had followed his General's example and gotten away before the surrender, and was in Sanfrancisco. We drove to S.F. and after being stalled for several days managed to talk to him for 30 or 40 minutes. He did a lot of talking but I have never been able to decide how much of what he said could be depended on.

He said our boy had been killed by machine gun and was buried in the Church Yard at Abucai "twelve steps right from the south center door". In Nov. 1945 a letter addressed to my son came from the Kansas City quartermaster's corp stating that they were holding some personal property of his. We wrote to them telling them he had been killed and after unraveling several miles of red tape they shipped us a trunk and several boxes he had consigned to the Philippines in August 1941. These things had evidentally never left the country.

The trunks had the locks broken and the boxes had all been opened and gone through. We called the railroad claim department, hoping that by making a complaint we might find out something, but aside from a card from the army giving us a claim number we heard nothing. As the claim was not what we were interested in we did not write any more.

As he had just arrived in the Philippines when the war started, we know of only two of his personal friends from whom we might have gotten information. One of these was Lt. Ninninger his chum through four years at West Point and we know he was killed as we read of his death when he received the Congressional Medal. The other, also a class mate was Lt. Hector J. Polla we assumed must have been killed also. We heard from another source that his Chaplain Father Sesna was killed in Japan in 1945.

A friend in the Army transport who was in Manilla several years ago tried to find out something for us, was told told that the 57th was a "suicide force" and had practically no survivors.

We made no attempt during the Roosevelt administration to get information from the Government as it was too evident that both Roosevelt and McArthur were determined that the truth of what happened out there should not get out, and so felt that we were up against a brick wall; but now that the Philippines are forgotten by the public, it occured to me that it might be possible to get some information from the Army files in Washington.

Naturally Mrs. Cheaney and I would treasure any information as to his life and movements during the two months he lived after reaching the Philippines and as to the place and circumstances of his death, and will greatly appreciate anything you might find out for us.






