Testing Lab Forensic Array Processing Results and Conclusions:

Samples HMG1913-0036-E01b (48ul of DNA extract @ 0.0277ng/ul) and HMG1913-0036-E01c (48ul of DNA extract @ 0.0183ng/ul) were submitted for processing using genome sequencing. Sample HMG1913-0036-E01b was selected for genome sequencing, and a call rate of 87.6% was obtained. These results are suitable for upload into GEDMatch.

The closest familial link is 750 shared centimorgans (cM), which is approximately in the 1st-2nd cousin range. Based on this information, further genealogical research was conducted by Bode.

The genetic information related to GEDmatch kit JZ1016141 (assigned alias: Barry W) was used to perform a genealogical search to provide an investigative lead to Mr. John Eakin. The sample information is to be used for RESEARCH and INVESTIGATIVE PURPOSES ONLY.

Recommendation:

Bode <u>recommends</u> further research into Arthur H. Kelder (1916-1942) as a possible candidate for these unidentified remains.

I, Melinde Lutz Byrne, citizen of the United States of America and resident of Indian River County in the state of Florida, make oath and say;


That I am a board-certified genealogist and a Fellow of the American Society of Genealogists providing my experience, knowledge, and belief upon request of law enforcement and under agreement with Bode Technology, Lorton, Virginia;

That Sample "BARRY" is sequenced DNA from bone extracted by Bode Technology from male human remains recovered after World War II and no further information has been provided (agency communications);

That autosomal DNA analysis and genealogical research produces the following recommendation:

Sample Barry is a first cousin once removed of both high test takers John James Eakin and Donna Sanger (married Fowl). Based on circumstances, ages, and dates, he is most likely Arthur H. Kelder (1916-1942).

Sample's Family Tree with Triangulating Matches





That this recommendation is based on genealogical research outlined and summarized below;

That Does (unknown human remains) qualify for law enforcement full access to test taker atDNA results in GEDmatch, currently a pool likely over 1 million kits (Terms of Service, GEDmatch);

That Sample is of 99% European origin, being primarily Western European (Exhibit A);

Biogeographical Origins of Sample







Although Sample Barry could be any grandson of Sytske Punter and Jacoba Punter, only Arthur fits all parameters and is proven to be the Sample by the triangulation with the two high test takers;
