## PLAINTIFF'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM ADR REFERRAL

Plaintiff files an Unopposed Motion for Relief from an ADR Referral in accordance with Local Rule C-88(g).

- 1. The Court referred this case to alternative dispute resolution on December 4, 2013 (see Docket No. 44, paragraph 4).
- 2. Local Rule CV-88(g) provides that a party may request relief from referral not later than 14 days after receiving notice of the referral. A party may obtain relief upon a showing of good cause.
- 3. Counsel for the Plaintiff has research the cost for three local San Antonio, Texas, mediators. The hourly rates for mediators range from \$125.00 per hour to \$250.00 per hour.
