**ORDER**

Before the Court is the status of the above case. This case has been referred to the undersigned pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b). (Docket Entry 4.) A hearing was held in this matter on July 16, 2014. In accordance with the Court’s rulings at the hearing, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

- (1) Plaintiff’s *pro se* Motion to Vacate Appointment of *Pro Bono* Counsel (Docket Entry 67), and Plaintiff Counsel’s Motion to Withdraw (Docket Entry 68) are **GRANTED**.
- (2) Plaintiff is granted leave to file a motion to compel discovery **within seven days** of the date of this Order. Any such motion must contain a certificate indicating that the parties have conferred on the matters addressed by the motion. Any response to such motion must be filed **within seven days** of the filing of the motion.
- (3) Plaintiff must respond to Defendants’ Motion to Dismiss on Suggestion of Mootness and Motion to Stay Discovery (Docket Entry 64) **within seven days** of the date of this Order.
