As we discussed today, I do not believe that it would be a fruitful use of time to meet with you regarding 120 document requests. As we noted in our motion to stay, these requests are duplicative, overbroad and irrelevant as well as exceedingly burdensome, in that many or most are not limited in time or scope (i.e., to PVT Kelder).

As Judge Bemporad indicated today, he views your case to be limited to PVT Kelder. I believe that most, if not all, information relevant to PVT Kelder has already been produced as part of the administrative record. If there are other documents that you believe are relevant, it would be much more productive for you to identify those, rather than for us to try to pick them out from among your 120 requests. Once you identify which document requests you believe to be relevant, then I would be happy to confer with you further.
