NOTICE

Defendants American Battle Monuments Commission, *et al.*, advise the Court and plaintiff that the planned disinterment of the ten graves at Manila American Cemetery is currently set to begin approximately August 12, 2014, rather than August 1, as previously stated. Once begun, the disinterment is expected to take 2-3 weeks.

Defendants do not anticipate further delays, but note that the date is somewhat fluid, due to the necessary scheduling of aircraft, deployment of mortuary personnel from South Korea, coordination with cemetery staff, and possibility of inclement weather, among other factors.
