Dear Mrs. Paige:

The Department of the Army desires that you be informed of the final determination of the investigation in the case of your brother. the late Private Charlie M. Waid.

Full consideration has been given to all available information pertaining to your brother since he died while a prisoner of the Japanese Government. According to information obtained from the Cabanatuan Prisoner of War Death Report, your brother died on 19 November 1942, as a result of beri beri and inanition at Cabanatuan Prisoner of War Camp, Luzon, Philippine Islands.

Subsequent to the reported death of your brother, units of the American Graves Registration Service disinterred all remains from the Cabanatuan Prisoner of War Cemetery and removed them to the American Graves Registration Service Mausoleum, Manila, Philippine Islands. In an effort to establish and/or verify identifications, these remains were subjected to exhaustive investigations, including processing by anthropologists and medical, dental and laboratory technicians in our Central Identification Laboratory at Manila. Our investigations have been impossible to identify any of the recovered remains as those of your brother.

After a detailed study of the negative results of the investigations and the pertinent facts regarding the case, the Department of the Army has been forced to conclude that the remains of your brother are not recoverable. I wish to assure you that, should any additional evidence come to our attention indicating that his remains are in our possession, you will be informed immediately.

Realizing the extent of your grief and anxiety, it is not easy to express condolence to you who gave your loved one under circumstances so difficult that there is no grave at which to pay homage. Hay the knowledge of your brother's honorable service to his country

of sustaining comfort to you.

1. Attached extracted copies of two (2)
Cabanatuan POW Camp rosters indicate that the above
listed personnel died at Cabanatuan POW Camp, Province
of Nueva Ecija, Philippine Islands on 19 November 1942.
This information is in agreement with the data shown on
the attached OQMO Forms 371, except for Cpl. John W.
Ruark, 278 681, and Pvt. Charlie M. Waid, 19 049 058,
who were determined dead as of 9 July 1943 and
9 November 1943, respectively.

2. Investigation of these cases reveal the following information:

a. Subject personnel are indicated on "Cabanatuan POW Camp Death Report" to have been buried together with five (5) other casualties in Communal Grave No. 717, Cabanatuan POW Cemetery. This grave has been disinterred and resulted in the recovery of fourteen (14) remains; four (4) of which are "Knowns" and ten (10) as "Unknowns". 

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

After examining it, I will return it promptly.

I would appreciate it if you would also be so kind as to give me the following information, and any other information which you deem important:

- 1. What is your relationship to Private Waid?
- 2. Is he married? If so, what is his wife's name and address?
- 3. What are the names and addresses of his closest relatives; i.e., oldest adult child, mother, father, oldest sister, oldest brother, et cetera.
- 4. Would you personally be willing to receive, receipt for, and safely keep and store his property as a gratuitous bailee?
- 5. If the property is delivered to you, will you agree to return it to him, his personal representative or the Army Effects Bureau upon request?

Please be assured that this communication does not purport to indicate that Private Waid is a casualty. Our only information is that he is missing. The sole purpose of this letter is to acquire information to enable us to make shipment to the person or persons with whom he would want his property stored.

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


