MOTIONS FOR LEAVE TO AMEND PLEADINGS.

The deadline for Plaintiff(s) to file a motion seeking leave to amend pleadings; or to join parties is December 30, 2016.

The deadline for Defendant(s) to file a motion (1) to designate responsible third parties, pursuant to Texas Civil Practices & Remedies Code § 33.004(a); (2) seeking leave to amend pleadings; or (3) to join parties is January 20, 2017.

If a settlement is reached, the parties should immediately notify the Court so the case may be removed from the Court’s trial docket.

PRETRIAL MOTIONS

No motion (other than a motion in limine) may be filed after this date except for good cause. The deadline to file motions (including dispositive motions and Daubert motions) is February 1, 2017. This deadline is also applicable to the filing of any summary judgment motion under Fed. R. Civ. P. 56 and any defense of qualified immunity. Leave of court is automatically given to file motions, responses, and replies not to exceed 30 pages in length. Fed. R. Civ. P. 6(d) does not apply to the time limits set forth in Local Rule CV-7 for responses and replies to motions.
