ORDER


For the reasons set forth in the memorandum opinion issued this date, it is hereby **ORDERED** that DOD’s motion [117] for an *Open America* stay is **GRANTED IN PART**. The above-captioned matter is **STAYED** until July 8, 2023.

It is further **ORDERED** that DOD shall make an interim production of M–Z Individual Deceased Personnel Files (“IDPFs”) by August 8, 2022, and every 30 days thereafter.

It is further **ORDERED** that DOD shall produce a status report by August 8, 2022, and every 30 days thereafter, that: (1) identifies the number of files produced, the volume (in gigabytes) of files produced, and the number of files remaining to be produced; (2) reports whether DOD remains on track to complete its production by the deadline above; and (3) explains what additional resources, if any, DOD intends to devote to producing plaintiff’s request. These status reports shall be contemporaneous with DOD’s interim productions of M–Z IDPFs.

It is **SO ORDERED**.
