## ORDER DENYING MOTION TO STRIKE

Previously, plaintiff John Eakin responded the defendants' motion for summary judgment and asked the court to sanction the defendants for withholding documents responsive to his requests under the Freedom of Information Act.<sup>1</sup> The defendants responded and asked the court to strike Eakin's motion for sanctions.<sup>2</sup> Eakin subsequently withdrew his motion for sanctions.<sup>3</sup> Withdrawing the motion for sanctions rendered moot the government's motion to strike the motion for sanctions.
