

He told us that the remains believed to be that of Gen. Fort were taken up by Givernor Cruz but there was a grave next to his that was believed to be an American.

That afternoon we came back and dug up that grave and recovered the remains. The skeleton was complete with all the teeth. A belt buckle was also found with a spread eagle and the year 1940.

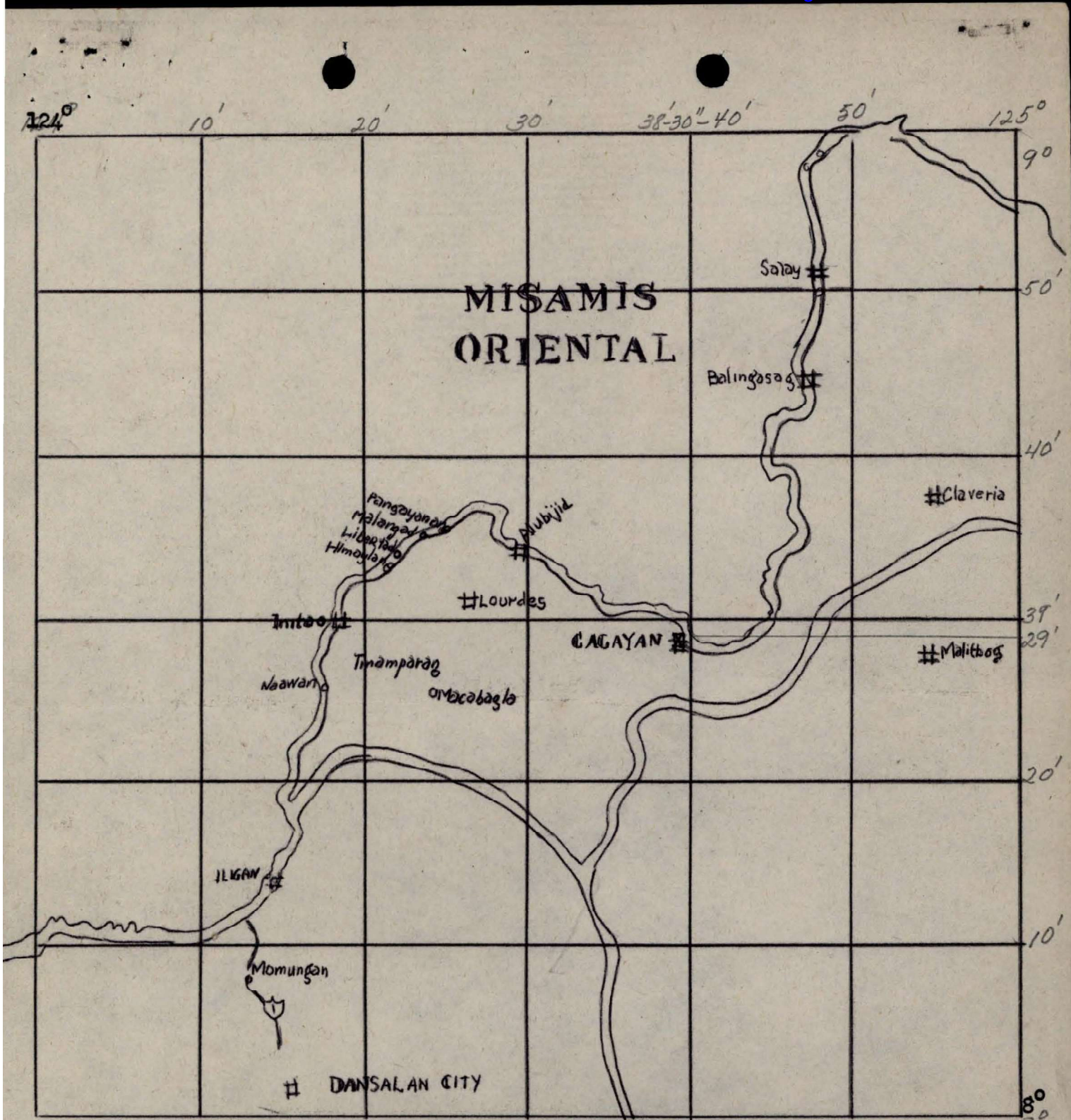

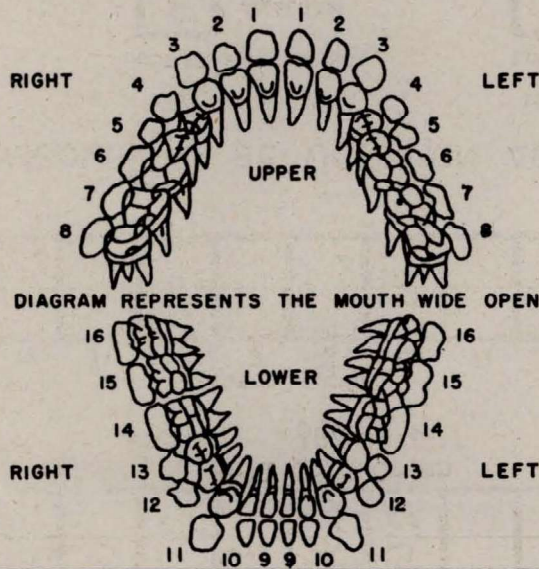


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN

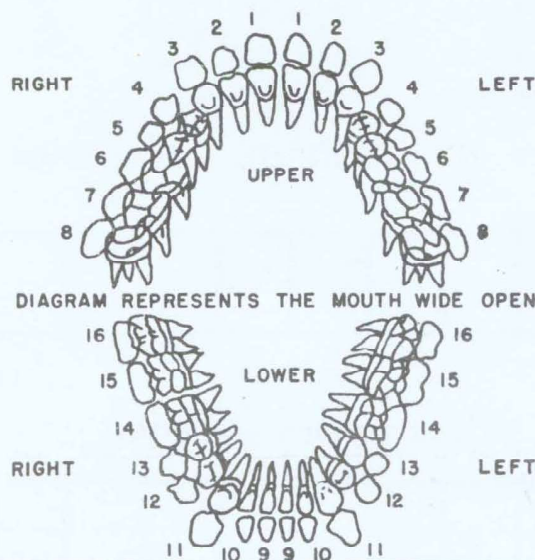


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
