**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF JOHN EAKIN**

I, John Eakin, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, declare as follows:

1. On April 1, 2019, I became aware of additional documents that support the conclusions expressed in my declaration dated March 28, 2019. These documents were not known to me prior to this date.

2. The attached pages are a portion of a burial map legend and contain the following information relevant to my prior declaration

Page 6 of 40 pages

**"Col. Stuart - 51st [sic] Inf. forward of Hacienda position on S-bank River." Map reference # 48.**

Page 19 of 40 pages

**"1st LT Maynard, David O-384762 57th Inf K.I.A. Bataan (Grave 17, Row 1) Abucay Cem."**


3. The information referenced above from page 6 supports my contention that the location of the grave of Col Stewart was well known to graves registration personnel. Note that

the name is misspelled "Stuart", but his rank, unit (57th Inf - there was no 51st Inf) and location of burial (Abucay Hacienda) are consistent with the information contained in X-3629.

4. The information referenced above from page 19 supports my contention that 1LT Nininger was buried in the Abucay Municipal Cemetery since Nininger and Maynard were assigned to the same unit and died during the same 24 hour period and almost certainly would have been buried near each other.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
