SECOND DECLARATION OF GREGORY J. KUPSKY

- I, Dr. Gregory J. Kupsky, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, declare as follows:
- 1. I am currently a historian in the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency's (DPAA) Indo-Pacific Directorate, and have served in that position since January 2017. Among other things, I am responsible for coordinating Directorate manning and case file preparation for Family Update conferences, and I am the lead historian for all research and casework on missing servicemembers from the Philippines. I also conduct archival research in the Washington, D.C. area to support DPAA's Hawaii-based operations. Additional details about my experience and credentials are set forth in my first declaration, dated March 15, 2019.
- 2. The statements contained in this declaration are based on my personal knowledge and DPAA records and information made available to me in my official capacity.
- 3. I have reviewed the documents titled Declaration of John Eakin, dated March 28, 2019 and Supplemental Declaration of John Eakin, dated April 1, 2019. I will address the documents described in Mr. Eakin's supplemental declaration.

- 4. The two pages Mr. Eakin attached to his declaration are excerpts from a single file, File 293, "List of Known Dead and Burial Locations with Some Map or Sketch Illustrations of American Military Personnel." The file is located in Box 185, Entry 1072, Philippine Archive Collection, Record Group 407, National Archives.
- 5. File 293 is a compilation of several different documents. It is an index of leads created by the Army Graves Registration Service (AGRS) in their recovery effort in the Philippines. It includes maps, along with an index by location and an index by name and rank. Mr. Eakin made use of pages from two distinct documents in the file.

Document 1: Cemetery & Organization Plot Locations

- 6. The first document is a two page document titled "Cemetery & Organization Plot Locations." *See* Exhibit 1. This document describes a number of established cemeteries along with other locations where servicemembers were reportedly buried or where recoveries had been made.
- 7. The second page of this document includes the line "Col. Stuart 51st Inf. forward of Hacienda position on S. bank River," and indicates that the location is No. 48 on the Bataan map.
- 8. The same page also includes the notation "31st Inf. (Am.) Cem. close to Guitol W. of Balanga Also 33rd Inf. (P.A.) Maj. Kaplan, Lt. Maynard this vicinity."

Document 2: Known Officer Dead & Buriel Locations

- 9. The second document is a 20-page document titled "Known Officer Dead & Buriel Locations." *See* Exhibit 2. This document provides an index by rank and name, and includes notes for "Where Killed,-Died,-Last seen Etc."
 - 10. The first page of this document includes the line "Colonel Stuart, Loren. Inf.

Killed Abucay Hacienda, - in front of position. (Not Rec'd)".

- The thirteenth page of this document (page 17 of File 293) includes the line
 "Maynard, David 0-384762 57th Inf K.I.A. Bataan (Grave 17, Row 1) → Abucay Cem."
 Explanation of Documents
- 12. Mr. Eakin is incorrect in concluding that the reference to COL Stewart in the first document demonstrates that "the location of the grave of Col. Stewart was well known to graves registration personnel." 2d Eakin Declaration ¶ 3. Instead, this entry merely indicates a lead that was being explored.
- 13. Confirmation that this was merely a lead rather than a certainty is found in the parallel reference in the second document, which specifies that COL Stewart was "Not Rec'd," i.e., not recovered. His loss location was known, but not his burial location, at the time these documents were created.
- 14. Similarly, Mr. Eakin is incorrect that the reference to 1LT Maynard in the second document confirms that 1LT Maynard was buried "in the Abucay Municipal Cemetery," and that 1LT Nininger could be expected to be found there too. 2d Eakin Declaration ¶ 4.
- 15. It is known that 1LT Maynard was not in fact buried in "Grave 17, Row 1" at Abucay Cemetery. That grave was identified as Philippine Scout Marciano Ragaza. *See* Exhibit 3.
- 16. As noted above, the first document identified a different lead for 1LT Maynard—a cemetery close to Guitol. Indeed, 1LT Maynard's IDPF includes correspondence between SGT Abraham and 1LT Maynard's father in December 1949 regarding this lead. *See* Exhibit 4.
- 17. In summary, these documents merely compile early leads in the recovery process and do not indicate that COL Stewart's or 1LT Maynard's remains were believed to have been

recovered, let alone identified.



Dear Mr Maynard:

Sorry I am a little late in answering your letters, I try to write and answer as many as I can in a day.

I am glad Dad McManis told you to write to me, probably Dad told you that I was the only one who remained in the Philippines, I stayed two extra years and returned home in 1947.

I established my headquarters in Balanga, Bataan, this spot is in the center of Bataan and from here I could work at any spot in Bataan, I worked according to leads, investigation revealed that their were 6 Officers buried at Guitol, Balanga, Guitol is not far from the Abucay battle line, I disintered the 6 and did not find any tags, the only thing I can do is take the remains to the Cemetery in Manila as unknowns, the bodies will remain as unknowns till the properly identify the deceased, I know Washington is doing all they can and probably later will secure the real identity, as I recall I sent in a lead on the 6 bodies as that of Lt David Manard, Maj Kaplan, Major Cleary, etc.

As for the burials at Abucay cemetery, I identified 9 as scouls I Americal Capt. whose name is Captain McCurdy and the other American as probable that of Lt Compton, as for Lt Wilson, he was disintered at Hermosa Bataan.

Hoping this information helps you out a lot, anything else I can help, just write to me and let me know.
