2. It is requested that the previously submitted individual identification recommendation of X-1801 as T/4 Lloyd O. Cole be withdrawn inasmuch as the recheck of all of the unknown remains recovered from Grave 212, Cabanatuan POW Camp Cemetery, has revealed that the remains of X-1801-A compared more favorably for individual identification as Pfc. Gerald W. Sparks. T/4 Cole's Form 371 dental chart contains no distinctive identification factors, whereas Pfc. Sparks' Form 371 did have two specific identification factors in ¹⁴-13 and R-15 which are in exact agreement with the dental chart for X-1801-A. T/4 Cole is now included among the six unknowns in the group identification.
