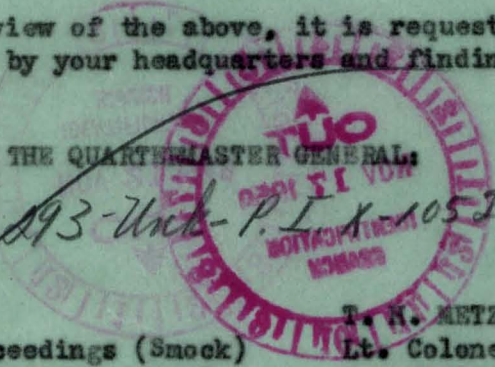
a. Circumstantial evidence is not conclusive enough to warrant identification.

Board Proceedings recommend the identification of X-3175 Manila Mausoleum (prev. X-1052, Manila #2) as Cpl. Claude C. Smock.

Remains were recovered from Soldiers grave 8, Abucay cemetery, Bataan. This is contradictory to information supplied by Major William R. Neelson that Cpl Smock was buried in dense undergrowth on the side of a hill in an unmarked common grave.

Tooth chart comparison is inconclusive. Comparison is based on fact that Cpl Smock had full upper and lower dentures as did the unknown.

Age estimation made by an anthropologist at the request of this Office is negative. Cpl Smock was fifty-four (54) years old. Age of the remains was estimated at twenty-six (26) to thirty-five (35).

Disapproval of identification is recommended.


S T A T E M E N T

Reference: UNK X-3175 Mausoleum

This remains was examined by me this date to ascertain the estimate age at time of death.

Due to erosion, important aging criteria on the post-cranial remains, such as the pubic symphysis were missing. Consequently, it was necessary to rely upon endo-cranial suture closures, and condition of the teeth, to derive an estimate age. The condition of the sutures would indicate that the individual was 26 to 31 years of age at the time of death, but the mandible present with the remains (which is properly associated) has a possible full lower denture, for all of the teeth are extracted. This would indicate a person somewhat older.

In the light of the few criteria available to age this individual, the estimate must be broad being 26-35 years.

DISAPPROVAL OF FIELD BOARD FINDINGS

Field Board Findings recommend the identification of Unknown X-3175 as Cpl Claude C. Smock, R-43118.

Cpl Smock, of Company "K", 31st Infantry, was killed in action 15 January 1942, at Abucay, Bataan, Philippine, Islands. Major William R. Nealson states that the bodies of Sgt Speers and Cpl Smock were found and buried in a "dry wash" on the intermediate slopes of Mt. Natib, near Abucay Hacienda.

The remains now stored as Unknown X-3175 in AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, P.I. (formerly Unknown X-1052 USAF Cemetery Manila #2, Luzon) were recovered from Grave 8, of Soldiers Row, Abucay Cemetery, Abucay, Bataan. Five (5) remains were supposedly recovered from this grave and identified as Americans by Gregorio Cunanan, grave-digger employed by the Americans before the surrender of Bataan. Reports of Interment for only three (3) Unknowns recovered from subject grave are of record in this Office.

Major Nealson states that due to the nature of the terrain and the intense vegetation identification of the grave of deceased would be difficult, whereas Unknown was disinterred from a civilian cemetery. It is not likely that the remains were removed from the original burial place and interred in the civilian cemetery in January 1942 or before the fall of Bataan.

Cpl Smock was 54 years of age at the time of death whereas the remains of Unknown X-3175 are those of a man between 26 and 35 years.

In view of the above, it is recommended that the identification of Unknown X-3175, as proposed by the Field, be disapproved.

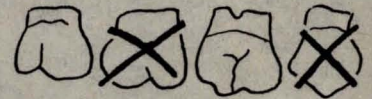

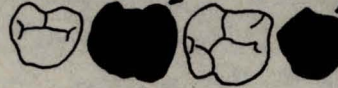
TOP VIEW

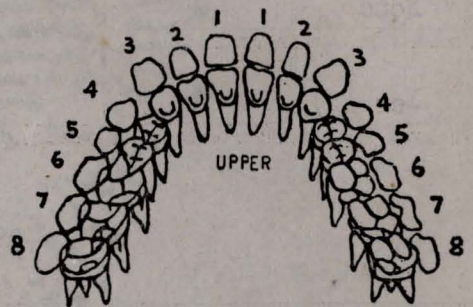
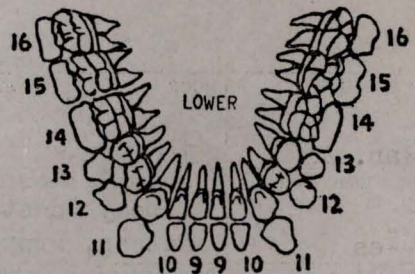
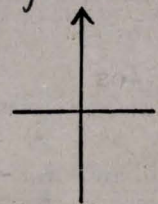


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
