S T A T E M E N T

Reference: Extra portions of human remains segregated during the processing of remains stored at AGRS Mausoleum, Manila.

In accordance with the provisions of OQMG letter, file QMGMP 293, dated 9 November 1948, subject "Disinterment Discrepancies," and OQMG radio - WOL 41899, all extra portions of human remains segregated by the laboratory personnel of CIP, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, were examined by me and separated into three (3) categories: (1) CIL Remains, (2) NON-CIL Remains, and (3) whole or fragmentary portions of maxillae and/or mandibles. The latter were given individual suffixes by cemetery.

These extra portions of human remains were enumerated by types of bones (cf., the eight enclosures), wrapped by types of bones, and then casketed with the following UNKNOWN numbers.
